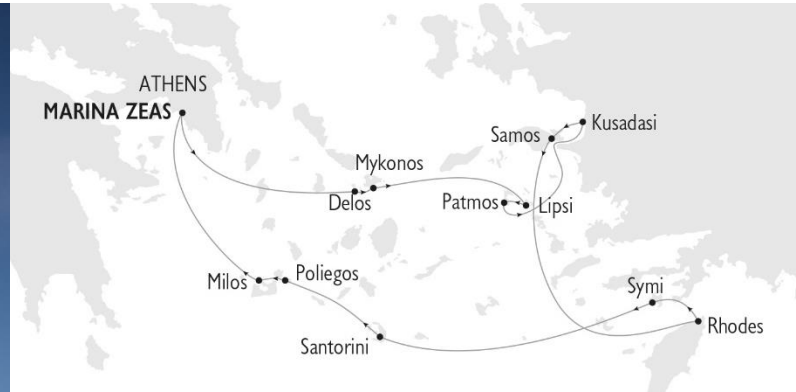

CABIN SPECIFICATION:

The 68-meter Mega Yacht Variety Voyager accommodates up to 71 guests in 36 cabins. 28 cabins are located in the Main and Lower Decks, and 8 staterooms sizes range from 16-20 m². Cabins at the Lower deck feature two oversized portholes and cabins at the Main and the Upper deck feature large windows. All cabins have individually controlled A/C and ventilation, mini-fridge, flat-screen TVs and DVD players. Bathrooms are finished with warm marble and Corian materials.

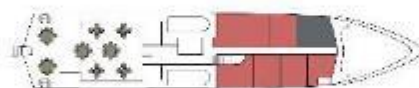

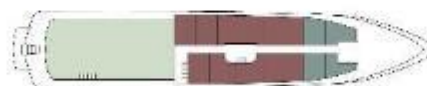

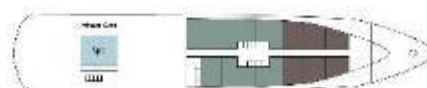

MAIN LOUNGE

Located on the Main deck, right off the reception area, the Main Lounge is gracefully designed and finished with wood panels. There is ample seating space for moments of pleasure or relaxation and modern AV equipment for presentations. The mini library, just off the Main Lounge, offers a variety of books and magazines.

DINING ROOM

Located on the Upper deck, the glass enclosed dining room seats 75 passengers and allows for spectacular views around you, while dining in an elegant environment. It extends to the adjacent open deck dining room, also seating 50 passengers and allowing for breakfast, lunch or dinner to be taken "al fresco". Itinerary

Day 1 – Friday: MARINA ZEA, ATHENS – CAPE SOUNION

Embarkation 14:00-15:00. We sail to Cape Sounion. Late in the afternoon, we reach Cape Sounion for Welcome Cocktails & dinner at anchor under the Temple of Poseidon. Departure and overnight at sea to Delos.

Day 2 – Saturday: DELOS – MYKONOS

This morning, enjoy breakfast at anchor in Delos. Enjoy an optional visit to tiny Delos, the mythical birthplace of Apollo and Artemis. On an [optional guided walking tour](#), you'll visit the archaeological ruins of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, unearthed here in the 19th century. Delos is a true open-air museum with many ancient monuments and buildings that are remarkably intact. After our 2 hour walking tour, we enjoy a refreshing swim stop and lunch, weather permitting. Later in the afternoon we sail into Mykonos Harbor. While exploring the town, you can visit the Archaeological museum or the Maritime museum, and make sure you enjoy Mykonos world famous night life! **Overnight in Mykonos. Early morning departure to Lipsi.**

Day 3 – Sunday: LIPSI - PATMOS

Morning swim stop in Lipsi Island. Swim stop and beach BBQ before sailing to Patmos. Afternoon arrival in Patmos and [optional Patmos excursion](#) includes two UNESCO World Heritage Sites, the Grotto and Monastery of St. John and the historic centre of the medieval town of Chora. Evening at leisure to discover Scala, the capital, or swim at a nearby beach. **Overnight in Patmos.**

Day 4 – Monday: KUSADASI – SAMOS

Early morning sailing to Kusadasi - Turkey. Today our explorations of ancient civilizations continue with an [optional tour to Ephesus](#), the greatest archaeological site in the Aegean region. As you tour this remarkably preserved Greek and Roman city, you may feel as if you're about to encounter a toga-garbed resident, or hear a chariot clattering down the main avenue, the same avenue down which Cleopatra and Mark Anthony rode in procession more than 2,000 years ago! After lunch we sail to the Island of Samos. Late afternoon, we reach Samos and the quaint port of Pythagorion. Late in the evening we sail to Rhodes. **Overnight at sea to Rhodes.**

Day 5 – Tuesday: RHODES – SIMI

Morning arrival in Rhodes. The island's medieval Old Town is one of the best preserved mediaeval settlements in the world and has been declared a Unesco World Heritage Site. [Morning Optional excursion](#) and sailing to nearby Simi Island, with a swim stop on the way. Late afternoon arrival at Simi, evening at leisure. **Overnight at sea to Santorini.**

Day 6 – Wednesday: SANTORINI

Early in the afternoon, we reach Santorini, formed by the half-submerged crescent of a volcanic caldera. You will go ashore and take a cable car to the town of Fira, a stunning cluster of white buildings atop a cliff. [Afternoon optional tour to Akrotiri](#), a city buried in the eruption that created the caldera in 1600 B.C and to Fira. The tour will end in Oia, famous for its sun set. Guests rejoin the ship in Oia. Late evening departure to Poliegos. **Overnight at sea.**

Day 7 – Thursday: POLIEGOS – MILOS

Early morning arrival in Poliegos, a very small island known for its amazing beaches. Morning swim stop followed by a BBQ on deck or at the beach. Early afternoon sailing and arrival at Milos, one of the most amazing and lesser known islands in the Aegean Sea. [Optional afternoon tour around the island.](#) **Captain's Farewell Dinner and overnight at sea to Marina Zea, Athens.**

Day 8 – Friday: MARINA ZEA, ATHENS

Breakfast and time to leave the ship - Disembarkation between 9 and 10 am.

PAYMENT

25% deposit is required 7 days from confirmation.

75% Balance of payment no less than 60 days prior to day of embarkation.

CANCELLATIONS

89 to 60 days from embarkation 25% of the cruise fare

NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE FARE
